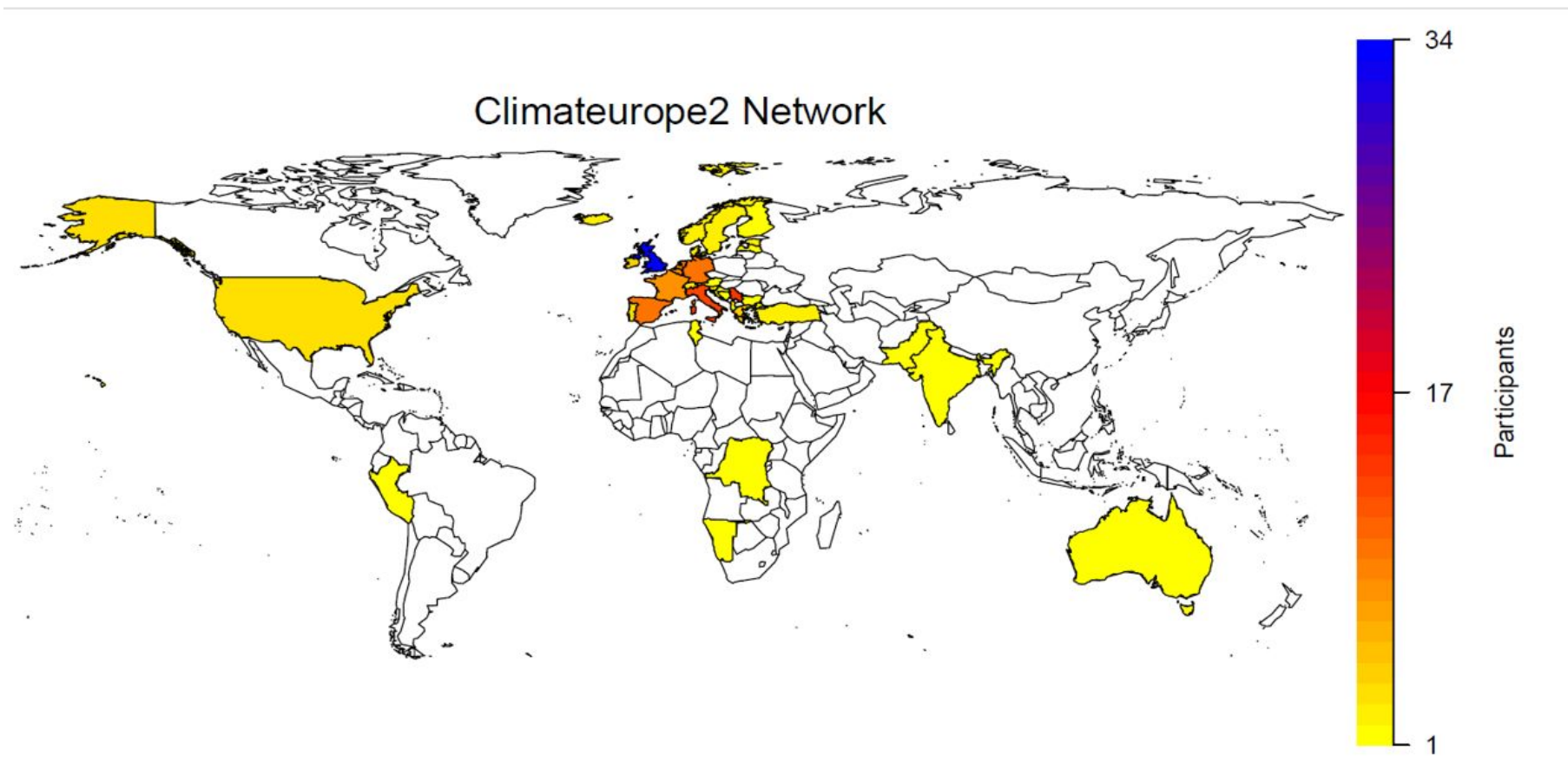

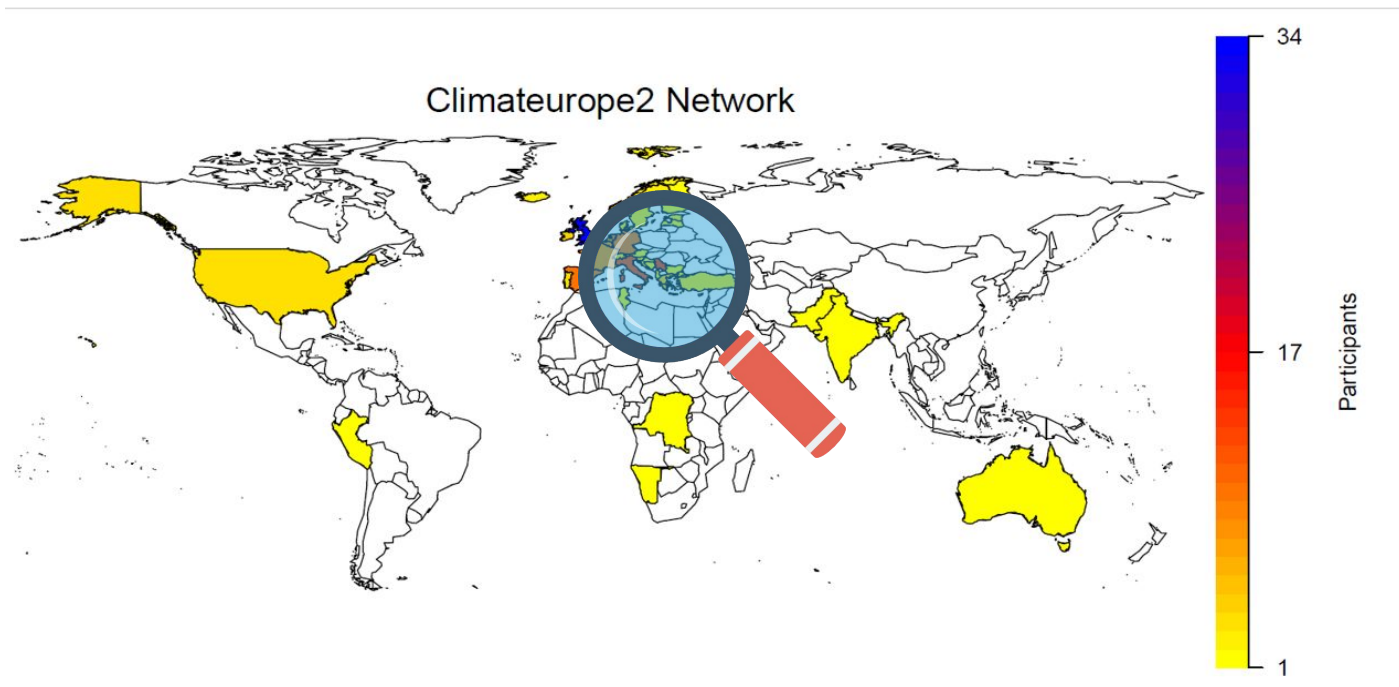

Innovative approach of the Roadshow



Climateurope2 offers public programmes dedicated to climate research in 10 countries of South-East Europe, as an innovative approach to expanding the community of users of climate services in this currently underrepresented European region.

The climate capsule and the Roadshow

- Through art and science initiatives CPN brings together the collaboration of creative minds coming from seemingly conflicting disciplines – art and science, while bringing science closer to the general public and increasing general scientific literacy.
- **The Climate capsule** - An experimental, mobile, and modular installation of an apocalyptic scenario of the world in the year 2057 where society did not take action on climate change and where reality is utterly different from today.
